Use the email <u>archives2reference@nara.gov</u>. They've got all the Deck Logs, but they charge \$0.80/page to copy it plus postage. They will only take a max 60-90 day window at a time. It can take 2-3 weeks to receive a response and another 30 days to process your order. A month can run about 55 pages (\$40) then estimated postage (estimate \$12-15 for 100 pages) They contact you after your request to get a credit card from you and give you an estimate of cost. There are a FEW, but not many, random months from various ships missing.
