 On 20 September 1969, the Chemical officer of this Headquarters visited Danang Naval Pase to investigate the tree and vegetation damage reported by reference (a). The exact cause of this damage could not be ascertained. However, the damage definitely did not result fre cerial chadeal or herbicide operations since none have been conducted in the Vicinity of the Naval Base.

In response to 4 request by this headquarters a plant Pathologist from PACY Chemical Operations Division visited your base on 24 September. A gasoline generator, which is filled from 55-gellon used berbicide drums. was noter. It was bearned from officers at the base that the generator was installed approximately four nonths ago and that the reported devage began appearing about three months ago. The durage is entirely localized at the base. These factors are significant.

3. Reference (h) states that damage to follisee can be caused by improper disposal of expty berbicide drums. It is probable that the cause of darage is the volatilization of herbicide in the generator. It is recoss ended that All herbicide barrels be reserved from the Neval Rase and that precautionary recogures be taken to preclude their increas in the future.
