Scheduling of Insecticide Spray Missions

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310th TAS

- 1. Scheduling of insecticide spray missions is the responsibility of the Wing Scheduling Officer (DOC-8). The scheduling officer will develop and publish a monthly schedule for two UC-1252 appray configured aircraft. This schedule will be equidinated with maintaines and published in sufficient time for inclusion in the Monthly Maintainess Plan. The schedule will be designed to meet the frequency of speny requirements outlined in 7AF Mag M/11152 Jul 71.
- 2. The final selection of the primary, secondary and tertiary energy locations will be made one day prior to the mission. The actual selection of the spray location will be made by the aircraft commander on the morning of the mission and will primarily be distated by mouther conditions.
- 3. The 310th TAS is responsible for providing aircrews to accomplish the insecticide apray missions and for conducting the pre-mission belofing required by PACAPH 55-123.
- 4. The Wing Scheduling Officer will menitor the quantity of melathion on each sirgraft and will coordinate the loading of malathion with Maintenance Control. Maintenance Control will contact PA & E and schedule the actual loading.
