SUBJECT: Report - The Toxicology, Environmental Fate, and Human Risk of
Herbicide Orange and its Associated Dioxin (Your Ltr, 21 Jul 78)

Chapters IV and VI references and findings should be checked against the data contained in the Environmental Protection Agency Rebuttal Presumption Against Registration and Continued Registration of Pesticide products containing 2, 4, 5-T (Federal Register, Friday, April 21, 1978, Part II).
