Activities: Week of June 4-8, 1984

1. The VA's Advisory Committee on Health-Related Effects of Herbicides will hold a meeting on Tuesday, June 5. The meeting will begin at 8:30 a.m. in room 119 of VA Central Office and is open to the public.

2. On Wednesday, June 6, the Senate Veterans' Affairs Committee will hold an oversight hearing on the Medical Inspector and Evaluation Office in assuring the quality of care within the Department of Medicine and Surgery. The hearing will take place at 10 a.m. in room 418 Russell Senate Office Building. Dr. John A. Gronvall, Acting Chief Medical Director, will be the Agency's lead witness. Mr. Frank S. Sato, VA's Inspector General, will accompany Dr. Gronvall.

3. No legislation affecting the Veterans Administration or its programs is scheduled to be considered by either the House of Representatives or the Senate during the week of June 4.
