
Pursuant to Postal Mgssage # 05012/TTM/TMPT, dated 11 February 1968, from the Combat Development and Test Center/JGS:

HEFERENCE : - Your Postal Message #2250/V2CT/UB202, dated 4 March 1968.

In order to meet the chemicals requirement of the II CTZ and to make chemicals available for the two new defoliants supply points of the Banch Hand Air Flight in Phu-Cat and Nha-Treng, the Combat usvelopment and Test Center/JOS has arranged with MACV/ COC7 to send to the II CTZ 3,200 red and white coses by the American Challenger ship. This ship will arrive in Qui-Thon by 3 April 1948, and 1700 cases aboard the Grenelle Victory ship will arrive in Nha-Trang on about 30 March 1968.

It is respectfully requested that your 202 Committee/ Headquarters direct the Ordnance Support Battalions concerned to make the quantity of chemicals available for the above two supply Points. The shipment and use of chemicals will be prescribed later by the Joint General Staff.
